Four hundred years ago Samuel de Champlain discovered Lake Champlain and the Europeans that followed established self sufficient settlements along the lake.

As agriculture expanded and modernized, the Champlain Valley became famous for milk, cheese, maple syrup, apples, potatoes, Morgan horses, and lumber. Our agriculture continues to evolve and once again we are gaining a diverse mix of farming enterprises that offer a wide range of farm fresh products.




